Networking Newsletters, Events and Venues

Heckers Development Group sponsors a monthly (except for August) "speed networking" event, and a monthly executive roundtable. Both are restricted to executives at the Director Level or above (Director, XVP, CXO). To our knowledge this is the Front Range's only event exclusive to top executives where there is a mix of levels and employed and "in transition" executives.

The "speed networking" event is similar to "speed dating" groups, and assures that everyone in the room meets everyone else. These are currently without charge, but space fills up very quickly, so click here to register for the next event.

Our clients and alumni participate in a twice-monthly (except for November, December and August, when it is one time a month) Executive Roundtable to discuss topics of interest to top executives, especially those in transition.

[The Association for Corporate Growth](#), ACG, is a group of prominent businesspeople and vendors interested in mergers, acquisitions, and company growth. They have a monthly luncheon with a speaker, and numerous other events. You are permitted to attend as a guest three times before being asked to join.

[The City Club of Denver](#): Theoretically a non-partisan group which discusses issues of public policy, the City Club of Denver is a delightful group of old Denver businesses and money. They meet Tuesdays for lunch at the Brown Palace. Interestingly enough, the membership and initiation fees are among the most reasonable for any group.

[Tie Rockies Venture Club](#) A group of entrepreneurs, Venture Capitalists, Angel Investors, and other private equity individuals and groups, mostly interested in technology business start ups and later-phase funding.

[Rockies Venture Club](#): A group of entrepreneurs, Venture Capitalists, Angel Investors, and other private equity individuals and groups, with interests in a wide range of businesses for start-up capital and later-stage funding.

[World Trade Center Denver 501 Club](#): International Business Club, meeting at the Brown Palace. Fairly high level folks. Attire is business/professional. They usually meet on the first Thursday of every month.

[LH3.com](#): Lauri Harrison's group puts on Schmoozelt and several other networking events. Their group, however, is very unreliable about actually keeping dates and times for their events, so don't get too attached to times or days. They are also not great about returning customer calls, as it really is pretty much one individual (Lauri) with some volunteers. But the events can be fairly good, though not as well attended or by as broad a group as in the past.

[CSIA](#): The Colorado Software and Internet Association is Colorado's premier IT organization. Membership is pricey, but this is a good place to contact "C" level executives, tech company owners, and vendors to the technical industry in Colorado.

[Colorado Society of CPAs](#): This is more than just tax professionals. Many CEO's, COO's, CFO's etc. belong to this and attend their meetings.

[Financial Executives International](#): These folks have a job support group for high-level Financial Executives that meets at Sherman and Howard. Call them for more info.

[Turnaround Management Association](#): A great place to meet "C" level folks and other involved in corporate turnaround.

**Free or Cheap and Religious Organization Networking Groups**

While there is some value to the free/cheap and religious organization networking and support groups, their advice should be taken with a grain of salt. These groups are usually run by volunteers who have very limited experience in job search.

[Pronetwork](#): A non-profit organization with a good mid-level networking group. Not terribly valuable for top level executives, but anything below a Director level will probably do fine.

[Northern Colorado Networking Group](#): Meets in Faith Evangelical Lutheran Church in Fr. Collins

[DiscoveryJobNetwork](#): A free networking group through the Roman Catholic Church of St. Thomas Moore. Non-sectarian in nature.

[Longnet Networking in Longmont](#)

[Collective Net](#): A group of networking clubs mostly in Northern Colorado. Lots of access to government job sites. Be cautious about résumé posting, as always.

[St. Andrew United Methodist Church Group](#): Again, mostly for mid-level folks.

[Our Father Lutheran Church Networking Group](#): Non-sectarian.

[Volunteer Match Site](#): Volunteering during a time of unemployment is often a way to meet new folks and network with “movers and shakers,” or, at least, their families. This site will match you and your skills and desires with a volunteer opportunity. While most volunteer gigs tend to be hewing wood and drawing water, some more high level positions do exist, especially if you’re willing to do fundraising.

[Colorado Shares](#): To stretch the eating dollar in times of unemployment, especially if you already volunteer, try Colorado Shares. In exchange for volunteering (anywhere that can be certified) you are able to purchase highly discounted groceries at a weekly “share” meeting. Sometimes government surplus or the like, but normally of pretty good quality. It usually includes items like fresh fruits and vegetables, cheese, peanut butter, rice, beans, a little meat, and so on. Only about half of those who take advantage of this actually *need* to do so, and there is no “needs test.”

[Jewish Business Alliance](#): Not free, but a good networking group with great events.

[Network Denver](#): The stated purpose is to match non-profits with volunteer board members and donors, but they also have great networking events.

## Chambers of Commerce

Every area or city has a Chamber of Commerce. Some are listed below, especially the “specialty” ones.

Most Chambers are composed of local smaller businesspeople. Even those where larger companies belong, however, rarely see anyone at the top level representing the company. So, spending time at public-access Chamber events can be a mixed bag.

However, if you qualify for a “specialty” Chamber, such as the Asian Chamber of Commerce, it doesn’t hurt to go and check it out.
